JESUS' CRUCIFIXION PART 3: HIS DEATH (Matthew 27:45-50)

- I. Jesus' Final Hours on the CROSS (Matt. 27:45-49; cf. Mk. 15:33-36; Lk. 23:44-45)
 - A. A supernatural DARKNESS (27:45)
 - 1. It came at MID-DAY
 - 2. It was WIDESPREAD
 - 3. It lasted THREE HOURS
 - 4. It SILENCED all the SCORNERS
 - 5. It STOPPED all ACTIVITY
 - It was supernatural in its OCCURRENCE, its TIMING, its DURATION, and its INTENSITY
 - B. A sovereign DEPARTURE (27:46-49)
 - Jesus SHOUTED, "My God, My God, WHY have You FORSAKEN ME?"
 - a. This occurred when He BECAME SIN for us (2 Cor. 5:21; cf. Isa. 53:5; Rom. 4:25; 1 Cor. 15:3; Gal. 3:13; 1 Pet. 2:24; 3:18; 1 Jn. 4:10)
 - b. He did not CEASE to be GOD

- c. He was temporarily SEPARATED from His FATHER
- 2. Jesus was MOCKED as if He were calling for RESCUE
- II. Jesus' DEATH (Matthew 27:50)
 - A. A SUFFICIENT death: He SHOUTED "It is FINISHED" (John 19:30)
 - 1. He had PAID the FULL PRICE for SIN
 - 2. Nothing we could contribute is ADEQUATE
 - 3. Nothing we could contribute is NECESSARY
 - B. A SELF-GIVING death: He DISMISSED His SPIRIT
 - 1. No one TOOK Jesus' life FROM HIM
 - 2. Jesus GAVE His life FOR US
