LACKING LOVE (Revelation 2:1-7)

- I. The ADDRESS (Rev. 2:1)
 - A. Specifically, to the *angelos* ("MESSENGER" or *angel*) of the CONGREGATION at Ephesus
 - B. Generally, to the WHOLE CHURCH
 - 1. From the Sovereign who HOLDS the messengers
 - 2. From the Sovereign who WALKS as JUDGE among the churches
 - 3. Based on absolute KNOWLEDGE
- II. The First COMMENDATIONS (Rev. 2:2-3)
 - A. Commended for their PERFORMANCE
 - 1. They were BUSY
 - 2. They were FAITHFUL (steadfast)
 - B. Commended for their PURITY
 - 1. They were MORALLY upright
 - 2. They were DOCTRINALLY orthodox
 - a. Demonstrated DISCERNMENT
 - b. Demonstrated COURAGE
 - C. Commended for their PERSEVERENCE
 - 1. They patiently ENDURED
 - 2. They did not FAINT
 - D. Commended for their PURPOSE: "for MY NAME'S sake"
- III. The CONDEMNATION (Rev. 2:4)
 - A. A GREAT failing
 - B. A GRADUAL falling
 - 1. A matter of the WILL: "LEFT" not "LOST"
 - 2. A matter of DEGREE: diminished FERVENCY

- a. Love of MONEY? (1 Tim. 6:10)
- b. Love of THE WORLD? (1 John 2:15*a*)
- c. Love of THINGS? (1 John 2:15*b*)
- d. Love of FAMILY? (Matt. 10:37; 1 Cor. 7:34)

IV. The COUNSEL (Rev. 2:5a)

- A. REMEMBER their FORMER position
 - 1. They had FALLEN
 - 2. They needed to RETURN to the point of DEPARTURE
- B. REPENT of failing fervency
- C. REPEAT the first works
 - 1. Not a call to renewed ACTIVITY
 - 2. But a command to refreshed ADORATION

V. The WARNING (Rev. 2:5b)

- A. Sudden JUDGMENT from the LORD
- B. Setting aside the assembly's USEFULNESS
 - 1. Still a "LAMPSTAND"
 - 2. But "out of its PLACE"

VI. The Second COMMENDATION (Rev. 2:6): HATING the works Christ also HATES

VII. The CALL and PROMISE (Rev. 2:7)

- A. The message from CHRIST is also from the SPIRIT
- B. Those who CAN must HEAR (cf. John 5:25; Rom. 10:17)
- C. Those who OVERCOME will be blessed (1 John 5:5)
 - 1. All who TRULY love CHRIST
 - 2. All will EAT of the TREE OF LIFE
 - 3. All will DWELL in God's PARADISE
