## JESUS' TRIUMPH OVER DEATH (Matthew 28:1-10)

- I. Genuine LOVE (Matt. 28:1)
  - A. They started EARLY
  - B. They went to "LOOK AT the GRAVE"
    - 1. Not without RISK
    - 2. Prompted by GRIEF
- II. Sudden TERROR (Matt. 28:2-7)
  - A. They encountered "an ANGEL of the LORD"
    - 1. Had DESCENDED from HEAVEN
    - 2. Had CAUSED a SEVERE EARTHQUAKE (cf. 27:51)
    - 3. Had OPENED the TOMB
    - 4. Had appeared in RADIANT GLORY
  - B. The guards QUAKED in terror and became UNRESPONSIVE
  - C. The angel SPOKE to the women
    - 1. Quieted their FEARS
    - 2. Acknowledged their LOVE for JESUS

- 3. Informed them of His RESURRECTION
- 4. Assigned them to TELL His DISCIPLES
- 5. Promised Jesus would MEET THEM in Galilee
- III. Great JOY (Matt. 28:8)
  - A. They were still AFRAID, but now JOYFUL
  - B. They left QUICKLY and RAN to SPREAD the NEWS
- IV. Profound WORSHIP (Matt. 28:9)
  - A. They were GREETED by JESUS
  - B. They fell at His FEET to WORSHIP Him
- V. Restored HOPE (Matt. 28:10)
  - A. They were ENCOURAGED by Jesus
  - B. They must "TAKE WORD to My BRETHREN"
    - 1. Who should "LEAVE for GALILEE"
    - 2. Who would SEE JESUS there
