## OVERVIEW OF HEBREWS

## I. Its THEMES

- A. WHY it was written
  - 1. To prevent Jewish CHRISTIANS from REVERTING to Judaism
  - 2. To present the PREEMINENCE of Christ over EVERYTHING
- B. HOW it uses the OT
  - 1. Uses predominantly the PENTATEUCH and PSALMS
  - 2. Almost always IGNORES the HUMAN writer (cf. 4:7; 9:19-20)
  - 3. Treats EVERY WORD as GOD'S
    - a. Twice attributes OT words to CHRIST (2:11-12; 10:5ff.)
    - b. Twice attributes OT words to HOLY SPIRIT (3:7; 10:15)
  - 4. Presents Christianity as the FULFILLMENT of OT Judaism

## II. Its THEOLOGY

- A. The CHARACTER of the Son
  - 1. His DIVINE pre-existence
  - 2. His HUMAN incarnation
  - 3. His EXALTED position

- B. The PRE-EMINENCE of the Son
  - 1. His superiority over the ANGELS (1:5 2:9)
  - 2. His superiority to MOSES (3:1-6)
  - 3. His superiority to JOSHUA (4:8)
  - 4. His superiority to AARON (4:14 5:10)
- C. The Son as HIGH PRIEST
  - 1. His GODLY CHARACTER
  - 2. HIS DIVINE APPOINTMENT
  - 3. His UNIQUE STATUS
    - a. Not connected to the priesthood of LEVI under the LAW
    - b. But connected to the priesthood of MELCHIZEDEK
- D. The Son's high priestly WORK
  - 1. The superior CHARACTER of His offering
  - 2. The superior EFFECT of His offering
- E. The Son's inauguration of the NEW COVENANT
  - 1. Not a covenant WITH a better PEOPLE
  - 2. But a covenant THROUGH a better MEDIATOR
