

JESUS' SUPERIORITY TO MOSES, PART 1
A COMPARISON AND CONTRAST
(Hebrews 3:1-6)

- I. The EQUIVALENCE of Their FAITHFULNESS (Heb. 3:1-2)
 - A. A REMINDER of what has been ESTABLISHED
 - 1. Jesus is the DIVINE Son of GOD
 - 2. Jesus became HUMAN to SUFFER and DIE for US
 - 3. Jesus is a MERCIFUL and FAITHFUL high priest for us
 - B. A charge to CONSIDER what Jesus has BECOME
 - 1. God's MESSENGER, proclaiming the TRUTH we must CONFESS
 - 2. Our HIGH PRIEST, representing US before the FATHER
 - C. Addressed to BELIEVERS
 - 1. Those who are now SANCTIFIED as BROTHERS
 - 2. Those who received "a HEAVENLY CALLING" by God's GRACE
 - D. An affirmation of FAITHFULNESS
 - 1. Jesus to "Him who APPOINTED Him" (Jn. 3:34; 5:36-37; 20:21)
 - 2. Moses in "all [GOD'S] house" (Num. 12:7)

II. The CONTRAST of Their NATURES (Heb. 3:3-4)

A. Moses was pre-eminent IN all GOD'S HOUSE

1. A LEADER worthy of "GLORY" and "HONOR"
2. But never MORE THAN a MEMBER of God's people

B. Jesus is pre-eminent OVER all GOD'S HOUSE

1. Worthy of "MORE GLORY" and "MORE HONOR"
2. Because He is the ARCHITECT and BUILDER of God's people

C. "EVERY house is built by SOMEONE"

1. The builder of ALL THINGS is GOD
2. Therefore, JESUS is GOD

III. The DIFFERENCE of Their POSITIONS (Heb. 3:5-6)

A. MOSES was a FAITHFUL SERVANT

1. He did as INSTRUCTED by his LORD
2. Served as a TESTIMONY of what JESUS would REVEAL (Deut. 18:15)

B. "CHRIST" was a FAITHFUL SON

1. He RULED the household Moses SERVED
2. WE are ALSO of His HOUSEHOLD

C. We must PERSEVERE

1. In our CONFIDENCE in Him
2. In PRIDE in His PROMISES
